TRAVELLING TO CKI

What do I need to do to travel to the Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

CKI residents returning from WA are not required to quarantine on their arrival back to the IOTs.

In addition, individuals, including essential workers – who have been in WA for the past 14 days, does not have COVID 19 and have not been in contact with a confirmed case, will also be permitted to travel to the CKI without quarantine on arrival.

All travellers must apply for travel approval to CKI using an electronic application form. The form is mobile-friendly and will automatically submit to the right email address (iotadministrator@infrastructure.gov.au). **Please allow at least 72 hours, excluding weekends**, prior to travelling for your application to be processed.

Each application received will be **reviewed** by the Territory Controller and the Administrator.

If approved, your **approval** letter **MUST** be **presented** to Virgin Australia staff, including at check-in.
