

CUSTODIAL CARE DEED

THE WESTERN AUSTRALIAN MUSEUM

and

SHIRE OF COCOS (KEELING) ISLANDS

BETWEEN

THE WESTERN AUSTRALIAN MUSEUM a body corporate constituted under section 7 of the *Museum Act 1969 (WA)* of 49 Kew Street, Welshpool, Western Australia ["Museum"]

and

Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands

- 1 <u>Definitions</u> In this Custodial Care Deed, unless stated otherwise, these terms have the definitions here given to them:
 - 1.1 "this Agreement" means a legally enforceable contract evidenced by this Custodial Care Deed including the Schedule which shall form part of this Agreement.
 - "Museum" means the Western Australian Museum a body corporate constituted under section 7 of the Museum Act 1969 (WA) of 49 Kew Street, Welshpool, Western Australia.
 - 1.3 "Owner" means the legal owner of the Object/s, or authorised representative of the legal owner.
 - 1.4 "Parties" means the Owner and the Museum.
 - 1.5 "Custodial Care Deed" is an arrangement where an individual, community or organisation has requested the Museum hold an Object/s on their behalf for the purpose of care and storage. This may be on a short, or long term basis, but it does not involve a transfer of ownership to the Museum.
 - 1.6 "Schedule" means the Schedule hereto.
 - 1.7 "Qualified personnel" means the Museum Conservation, Curatorial and/or specialised Exhibition and Design staff or similarly qualified person/s appointed by the Museum.
 - 1.8 "Object/s" means the artefacts/items/works described in Item 1 of the Schedule.
 - 1.9 "Description" means the description set out in Item 2 of the Schedule and includes dimensions of the Object/s.
 - 1.10 "Condition" means the condition of the Object/s set out in Item 3 of the Schedule.
 - 1.11 "Agreed Insurance Value" means the value specified in Item 4 of the Schedule.
 - 1.12 "Proof of Valuation" means the estimation of the value of an Object/s in writing, by one of the principal auction houses. If a valuation cannot be provided, the Agreed Insurance Value will be subject to the discretion of the Museum.
 - 1.13 "Term" means the period that the Object/s are to be held, specified in item 5 of the Schedule.
 - 1.14 "Expiry Date" means that date specified in item 5 of the Schedule.
 - 1.15 "Additional Term" means that period specified in item 6 of the Schedule.

1.16 "Special Conditions" means those conditions specified in item 7 of the Schedule.

Agreement

- 2 I, Frank Mills, sign this agreement as the authorised representative of the owner of the Object/s.
- 3 The *Museum* agrees to hold in custody the *Object/s* for the Owner, Shire of Cocos and (Keeling) Islands represented by Frank Mills.
- 4 The *Museum* will take all reasonable care of the *Object/s*.
- 5 Unless otherwise arranged, the *Owner* will be responsible for transporting the *Object/s* to and from the *Museum* premises at the commencement and expiry of this *Agreement*.
- 6 Unpacking and storage of the *Object/s* will be undertaken by *Qualified personnel*.
- 7 At the time of unpacking, a *Description* of the *Object/s* and state of their *Condition* will be documented, in the format provided in the *Schedule*. This process will be completed by *Qualified personnel*.
- 8 The *Museum* may not make any changes to the *Condition* of the *Object*/s without the prior written consent of the *Owner*.
- 9 The *Owner* authorises the *Museum* to photograph the *Object/s* specifically for the purpose of documentation of this *Agreement*.
- 10 The *Owner* will be notified immediately if any loss or damage occurs to the *Object/s*, including any discovered on first receipt/delivery.
- 11 The Agreed Insurance Value of the Object/s will be as per the Proof of Valuation.
 - 11.1 If a valuation cannot be provided, the *Agreed Insurance Value* will be subject to the discretion of the *Museum*.
 - 11.2 The Agreed Insurance Value cannot be disputed in the case of damages.
- 12 Unless the *Owner* states otherwise in writing, the *Museum* will insure the *Object/s* for the *Agreed Insurance Value* noting the interest of the *Owner*.
- 13 The Property Insurance coverage arranged by the Museum through the RiskCover Fund will include cover for physical loss, damage, destruction or theft of *Object/s* caused by any event covered under such insurance from the time the *Object/s* arrive at the *Museum* premises until the time the *Object/s* are returned to the *Owner* or authorised representative.
 - 13.1 The parties agree that in the event of partial loss or damage of the *Object/s*, specialised repair and restoration may be the option that is more cost effective without losing the integrity and value of the *Object/s*.
- 14 The *Object*/s will be held for the *Term* commencing and expiring on the dates set out in item 5 of the Schedule.
- 15 Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the *Object*/s will be stored at the *Museum's* Collection and Research Centre, at 49 Kew Street, Welshpool, Western Australia.
- 16 This Agreement may be renewed for an Additional Term, but only if:
 - **16.1** The *Owner* notifies the *Museum* in writing of their interest to extend the *Agreement* for the *Additional Term*.
 - 16.1.1 Notification of intent to extend the *Term* of the *Agreement* must be provided to the *Museum* at least one month before the *Expiry Date*; and

- The *Museum* must approve the extension of this *Agreement* in writing prior to the *Expiry Date*.
- 17 The *Museum* will provide access to *Object*/s by the *Owner*, for inspection, conservation, or other agreed purpose.
 - 17.1 Visits will be arranged in advance with consideration of the convenience of all *Parties*.
- 18 The *Owner* of the *Object*/s may retrieve one, some or all of the Object/s at any time during the *Term* subject to:
 - 18.1 Written notification of arrangements agreed by the *Parties*.
- 19 The Special Conditions, if any, set out in the Schedule, form part of this Agreement.
 - 19.1 If there is any conflict between clauses 1 to 20 inclusive, of this *Agreement* and the *Special Conditions*, then the latter shall prevail to the extent of the conflict.
- 20 This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
